Rights Action recommends this 25 minute report on the assassination of Berta Caceres and attempted assassination of Gustavo Castro, in the aftermath of the 2009 U.S. and Canadian backed military coup, and the ensuing spike in foreign investment that contributes to and benefits from Honduras' systemic repression, corruption and impunity.

The human rights situation in Honduras remains desperate and completely normalized by the "international community" – particularly the governments of the U.S. and Canada, a host of inter-governmental financial institutions (World Bank, Inter-American Development Bank, IMF, etc.) and a whole host of predominantly U.S. and Canadian companies and investors – that legitimize and empower the military back regime in power, turning a blind eye to the repression, corruption and impunity that the "international community" contributes to and benefits from.
